Day 1



1 night Otjimbondona – Windhoek

Upon arrival you will be transferred by a light aircraft to Otjimbondona which is a 15 to 20 minutes flight. Otjimbondona Kalahari is situated on a 3000 hectare Private Nature Reserve on the fringes of the Namibian Kalahari.

The boutique retreat has four delicately decorated villas with king-size beds and en-suite bathrooms. Each villa has its own lounge with a fireplace and DStv, a kitchenette and its own plunge pool.



The retreat also offers guests a large lounge and dining area, a kitchen, a swimming pool, a boma for outside braais, a sauna and a gym. The accommodation at Otjimbondona Kalahari is all inclusive of meals, drinks, laundry and two nature drives

Day 2/3



2 nights Little Kulala – Sossusvlei

Depart from Otjimbondona by air and enjoy awe-inspiring views of the mountains and the desert floor.

Spend two nights exploring the Sossusvlei region, staying in the Kulala Wilderness Reserve, which provides convenient access to the splendour of the towering red dunes of the Namib. Activities at Little Kulala start with morning guided game drives to the spectacular dunes of Sossusvlei and include a visit to the fascinating Sesriem Canyon, scenic sundowners and hot air balloon excursions (at extra cost; weather dependent).

Day 4/5



2 nights Sorris Sorris – Damarand

Today you will fly to Damaraland with a stopover in Swakopmund for refuel. You will fly to Uis, the nearest airstrip and then have an hour road transfer to the lodge.

Dramatic piles of mesmerizingly balanced granite boulders in a rugged desert landscape set the perfect backdrop for Sorris Sorris Lodge. The lodge encapsulates a modern expression of African architecture, with an outdoor pool offering panoramic views over the Ugab River and the Brandberg Massif.

The dining, pool, guest lounge and bar area are on an elevated deck with panoramic views over the Ugab River and the Brandberg massif. Rooms and public areas connected by raised wooden walkways.

Day 6/7



2 nights Serra Cafema

Today you will be flying to undoubtedly one of the most remote camps in southern Africa.

Serra Cafema is located in the extreme north-west of Namibia on the banks of the Kunene River in the Hartmann's Valley. Serra Cafema is an intimate, peaceful camp inspired by the area's Himba people, with a unique mix of rustic and luxury elements, and nestled amongst shady albida trees

Day 8/9



2 nights at Little Ongava - Etosha National Park

Continue to Ongava Game Reserve on your private air transfer by light aircraft. The flight reveals the considerable contrast of the stark and rocky scenery of Damaraland and the Kaokoveld and the richer woodland areas and grassy plains of wildlife-rich Ongava and Etosha. Stay for two nights at Little Ongava. Little Ongava Lodge is scenically nestled around a rocky outcrop and overlooks the vast plains beyond plus a productive waterhole that is floodlit at night.

Ongava reserve serves as a base for Etosha National park visits.

Day 10/11



2 nights at Nambwa Lodge – Okavango and Caprivi

To complete your Namibian journey, today you will fly to the far north east which is completely different and which will give you a taste of the Okavango.

Nambwa Lodge is located in the Zambezi Region of Namibia, on the banks of the Kwando River, within Bwabwata National Park. It provides a sanctuary for more than 35 large and small game species and upwards of 330 bird species. These animals move freely throughout the area which creates a mecca for wildlife viewing. It is the only lodge in the area approved for night game drives. Adventure activities, along with authentic cultural and community experiences, are on offer.

Day 12
