### Day 1



#### 1 night at the Elegant Guesthouse – Windhoek

Pick up your rental car upon arrival at Windhoek International Airport and set off on the easy 45-minute drive to reach Namibia's capital of **Windhoek**. Spend the afternoon relaxing at the Guesthouse or take an optional City Tour. Late Afternoon you will be picked up from the Guesthouse and taken for Dinner, where the complete tour will be discussed with you.

### Day 2



#### 1 night at Gaub Guestfarm – Central Highlands

Today you drive north with a visit to the **Cheetah Conservation Foundation** en- route to the heart of Otavi Mountains to Ghaub Guest Farm which was a mission station from 1895 to 1968. There are lots of **activities** - walking trails to past bushman engravings, an old fountain, a cave and the mission station cemetery. Alternatively, explore Ghaub's area on a nature/farm drive in a 4WD in search of game

### Day 3 & 4



#### 2 nights at Onkoshi Camp – Etosha National Park

After breakfast you travel to the **Etosha National Park** north of Namutoni to the exclusive Onkoshi Camp inside the National Park on a private peninsula of Etosha Pan. The accommodation is luxurious and exclusive. Easy to drive yourself around the park between sunrise and sunset. Etosha is home to different species of birds, many of Africa's big-game animals (including lion, leopard, cheetah, elephant, giraffe and rhino), and a myriad of fascinating smaller ones.

## Day 5 & 6



### 2 nights at Ongula Village – Owamboland

Driving through a small part of the Etosha National Park continue further north to 4-O region, the most densely populated region of Namibia (approximately 600 000 people). The Ovambo tribe in Namibia consist of 8 sub-tribes. At the Village Homestead Tour you will see the preparation and cooking of local / traditional drinks and meals, discover the art of basket weaving and pottery. **Day 6 a visit to the Nakambale Museum**, open / craft markets and tribal house visits.

## Day 7



### 1 night at Opuwo Country Hotel – Kaokoland

Travel through the Omusati region. Flat, sandy plains dotted with makalani palms, savannah and mopane woodlands characterize the landscape to Opuwo Country Hotel, overlooking the untouched wilderness. This land is harsh, inhospitable and fascinating, creating a delicate balance between survival and obliteration.

## Day 8 & 9



### 2 nights at Khowarib Lodge – Kaokoland

You travel south to the edge of Kaokoland , an area so vast and rugged it ranks as one of Earth's last true wilderness areas where time has stood still for millennia. **Day 9 - guided tour** where you explore the region and discover and meet the fascinating **Ovahimba people and discover their way of life, track rhino on foot, search for desert-adapted elephants or simply enjoy the impressive scenery at sunset.**

## Day 10 & 11



### 2 nights at Doro !Nawas – Damaraland North

You depart today to Doro !Nawas, in the Abu-Huab River valley, a classic safari camp with the benefit of modern architectural and the spectacular views of the Etendeka Mountains and the red sandstone cliffs.. **Day 11 - a Nature drives to Twyfelfontein** and tour of the ancient rock paintings and engravings; **Burnt Mountain; Organ Pipes.** Wildlife is not a feature but you may well see desert-adapted elephants and other animals in the Abu-Huab Riverbed.

## Day 12 & 13



### 2 nights at Hohenstein – Damaraland South

Today you drive south past the **Brandberg Massif** being the highest peak in the country to the lodge in the **Erongo Mountains** where the stone-age inhabitants, Bushmen and Damaras settled on the bottom of the Hohenstein. **Day 13 visit the Living Museum** and get an interesting insight into the ancient hunter-gatherer culture and the traditional way of the **San**. Different programs are offered, the bush walk or a traditional hunt. You can also visit the **Boulder Forrest** and the **small miners** on the Lodge Premises.

## Day 14



### 1 night at The Elegant Guesthouse – Windhoek

Today you return back to Windhoek. In the afternoon 14h00 is a +- 3 hour city tour which will give you a stunning view over Windhoek from the famous Schwerinsburg while you get to know the comprehensive history of Windhoek and Namibia from colonial era to modern day. We visit the Christ Church, Ink Palace, Parliament Gardens, Rider Memorial, Train Station and the Old Fort.
